Entrance Antiphon: I have risen, and I am with you still, alleluia. You have laid your hand upon me, alleluia. Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia.

Theme: Today, we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ and proclaim the hope of our salvation and the defeat of death. Gospel says that the women from Galilee go to the tomb to anoint Jesus' body. First, they discovered that the tomb was empty; then they saw two figures in dazzling garments who told them that Jesus was risen. The apostles do not yet understand about the Resurrection even after having seen the empty tomb and the burial cloths. Gospel readings from our liturgy will show us how the disciples came to believe in Jesus' Resurrection through his appearances to them. Our Easter faith is based on their witness to both the empty tomb and their continuing relationship with Jesus-in his appearances and in his gift of the Holy Spirit. The message of Christ's resurrection proclaims that death is not the end. Easter takes us beyond death and brings hope into our lives. Easter inspires us and invites us to live in hope.

Communion Antiphon: Christ our Passover has been sacrificed; therefore, let us keep the feast with the unleavened bread of purity and truth, alleluia, alleluia.
