Entrance Antiphon: Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

Theme: Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to reflect on God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity—one God in three persons. The core of this doctrine is the recognition that God exists eternally in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. One of the most striking aspects of the Holy Trinity is the unity that exists between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Despite being distinct persons, they are united in their nature and purpose. On Trinity Sunday we meditate on the doctrine of faith revealed by Jesus and handed down through his apostles. Although the doctrine of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance through the teaching of Jesus that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus, and the Spirit also share all. Christ promises that whatever shape the future takes, we will have the assistance of the Holy Spirit who will continue to guide us in the absence of Jesus.

Communion Antiphon: Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.
