**Entrance Antiphon:** O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon me or forsake me, O God, my Saviour!

Theme: The gospel passage reminds us of our missionary call. God made us his people and reconciled us in Jesus. Our mission, like the apostles and Jesus, is to proclaim His kingdom. The disciples were sent out to continue the work that Jesus had begun. The ministry of Jesus is now the ministry of his disciples. Matthew's Gospel elaborates on the work of the Community, which is to continue after Jesus' death and resurrection. The Gospel reports that Jesus commissions twelve disciples. Matthew lists the name of the twelve disciples or apostles. Apostle means 'one who is sent'; they are sent by Jesus to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. As we reflect on this passage, we are called to examine our own lives and ask ourselves whether we are living up to our mission. Jesus has promised to be our God and to walk with us on this journey of faith, guiding us and strengthening us along the way.

**Communion Antiphon:** There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.
