Entrance Antiphon: Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.

Theme: Jesus reproaches people who have witnessed his mighty deeds yet lack faith. Gospel explains the reason for this unbelief and reveals what is necessary for faith. Jesus uses the image of a child to communicate our relationship with God. It is through faith that each of us establishes a relationship with God. The rewards of faith can only be achieved through purity of the heart. It is not human wisdom and worldly power that brings God into our lives, but childlike innocence. For Jesus personal holiness is the path to God, in contrast to the practice of the Mosaic Law taught by the Pharisees. God reveals everything in and through Jesus to all those who are innocent and faithful. Through the celebration of sacraments and liturgy let us also aspire to grow in faith and innocence.

Communion Antiphon: Come to me, all who labour and are burdened, and I will refresh you, says the Lord.
