Entrance Antiphon: Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I cry to you all the day long. O Lord, you are good and forgiving, full of mercy to all who call to you.

Theme: Happy Father's Day! We honour our fathers, fatherhood and paternal bonds, as well as the influence of fathers in our society. Father's Day gives us the chance to show appreciation for the important father figures in our lives. Today, let us pray for all fathers, grandfathers and all those who are like fathers to us.

Gospel: After Apostle Peter proclaimed Jesus as the promised Messiah, Jesus foretold the apostles his future suffering, death, and resurrection, prompting Peter's protest. Jesus tells his disciples what it really means to be the Messiah, in contrast to the popular view that the Messiah would be a political liberator; a king who would free Israel from Roman rule. Christ plainly tells the Apostles that the Messiah is the suffering servant of God, and not a political liberator. Once Jesus tells his followers what kind of Messiah he is to be, he draws out the implications for them. He warns them that the true disciples will live the same kind of life as their master; misunderstood, persecuted, rejected, and facing the danger of death. Jesus motivates his followers to embrace selflessness, mirroring Jesus' profound dedication to humanity.

Communion Antiphon: Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.
