Entrance Antiphon: Give peace, O Lord, to those who wait for you, that your prophets be found true. Hear the prayers of your servant, and of your people Israel.

Theme: The readings focus on mercy and forgiveness. In the gospel Jesus tells the parables about mercy and tells Peter to forgive "seventy times seven." Christ demands that we forgive one another not only because it is the compassionate thing to do, but also it is how God acts and expects us to act. It is the very "being" of God to forgive. By forgiving, we choose not to let any offense that has happened control how we continue to relate to one another. There is a temptation to quantify forgiveness. Jesus' response to Peter is a way of reminding us that God forgives us countless times. Our "heavenly Father" has shown us the way. If we hoard God's mercy while showing no mercy to others, we risk forfeiting the effects of God's mercy in our live. Let us forgive one another "from the heart" as we approach our merciful God.

Communion Antiphon: The chalice of blessing that we bless is a communion in the Blood of Christ; and the bread that we break is a sharing in the Body of the Lord.
