Entrance Antiphon: I am the salvation of the people, says the Lord. Should they cry to me in any distress, I will hear them, and I will be their Lord for ever.

Theme: The readings for this Sunday highlight God's generosity. Christ explains it in the parable about the workers in the vineyard and the generous landowner who paid them all the same wage. On the surface, the parable of the workers in the vineyard appears to be an offense to common sense. Those who work a longer day ought to be paid more than those who work just an hour or two. A close read shows us that the landowner paid on the terms that were negotiated and we come to see that the landowner is not simply just, but he is radically just. The parable reminds us that although God owes us nothing, he offers abundantly and equally. Jesus wants to highlight that the kingdom of God is a place of forgiveness and generosity. We often think that our own actions deserve more reward; and so, fail to seek God's generosity and mercy. Let us pray for God's mercy upon all of us.
