Entrance Antiphon: Within your will, O Lord, all things are established, and there is none that can resist your will. For you have made all things, the heaven and the earth, and all that is held within the circle of heaven; you are the Lord of all.

Theme: Today's Gospel highlights the ongoing tension between Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders. The chief priests and elders questioned Jesus and the source of his authority. In reply Jesus told them the parable of the vineyard and the wicked tenants. The parable narrates the actions of the unfaithful tenants of the vineyard, wherein Jesus recounts how the tenants of the Lord's vinevard rejected God's prophets. The parable is directly connected to the mission of God, through Jesus Christ. God is seeking justice and love from everyone he created. This parable invites us to be faithful servants and good stewards of the gifts that God has given us. Let us offer the Eucharist in reverent gratitude due to God.
