He urged leaders to avoid hypocrisy and to remain true to their beliefs. In simpler terms, Jesus, being a faithful Jew, urged leaders to walk the talk and stay true to their beliefs. He wanted them to avoid leading people astray. This lesson applies to leaders today as well. Christ wants us to proclaim the Scriptures in the way we live and relate to one another. The humbler we become, the easier it is for others to understand God's presence in us.
