Entrance Antiphon: Let my prayer come into your presence. Incline your ear to my cry for help, O Lord

Theme: Jesus tells the parable of the wise and foolish virgins. The parable stresses the importance of being prepared and vigilant. The 'cry' that goes up when the bridegroom arrives, capturing the festive joy of the occasion, tells us of the eagerness with which the first Christians looked forward to the Lord's return. The whole point of this parable is that we must be ready for the Lord. In a practical sense, this could mean regular prayer, ethical actions, and ongoing self-improvement. These "reserves of oil" enable us to face whatever comes our way with a readiness that aligns with our spiritual and ethical foundations. Probably all of us who are here want to be with the Lord. Do we live our lives in such a way that we are always ready for him?

Communion Antiphon: The Lord is my Shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose, near restful waters he leads me.
