**Entrance Antiphon:** Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.

**Theme**: The third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete is the Latin word meaning "rejoice." Candle for this Sunday is pink, and it signifies Joy. It is a joyful reminder that our salvation is near. "The Lord is near."

In John's Gospel, we encounter John the Baptist, the herald of the Light, embodying the role of a witness to the one true Light, Jesus Christ. This Light, which John testifies to, is the same Light that Isaiah foretells will bring freedom and renewal. The call in Thessalonians to rejoice always and give thanks in all circumstances is a response to this Light that illuminates our path, revealing the way to truth and salvation. As we journey through Advent, we are reminded that our preparation for Christ's coming is not only a remembrance of a historical event but an active participation in the unfolding of God's redemptive plan. Advent season is a time of deep spiritual renewal and expectant waiting for the fullness of God's salvation.

**Communion Antiphon:** Say to the faint of heart: Be strong and do not fear. Behold, our God will come, and he will save us.
