Entrance Antiphon: O sing a new song to the Lord; sing to the Lord, all the earth. In his presence are majesty and splendour, strength, and honour in his holy place.

Theme: The Gospel reading introduces us to the beginning of Jesus' public ministry and invite us to be transformed by the call of Jesus. The arrest and imprisonment of John the Baptist was a time of great distress and confusion for his followers and family. Christ was deeply saddened by John's imprisonment, but he suddenly transforms the situation by launching his public ministry. He continues from where John was stopped. Jesus calls his apostles. They recognised the greatness of Jesus and felt a liberating and transforming force in his call. They were willing to give up their comfort and securities of life, and their response to Jesus's invitation was immediate. Do we willingly respond to Christ's invitation? What do we do to bring liberty, freedom, and security to the suffering people?

Communion Antiphon: I am the light of the world, says the Lord; whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.
