Entrance Antiphon: Be my protector, O God, a mighty stronghold to save me. For you are my rock, my stronghold! Lead me, guide me, for the sake of your name.

Theme: Today's Gospel reports the miraculous healing of a leper. The readings demonstrate the healing power of Jesus and his ability to rid us of what is unclean in our lives. The leper recognises Jesus as the source of his healing, and he kneels reverently before him and asks for his salvation. Lepers were condemned as sinners and unclean. They were prohibited to approach holy places and clean people. But the leper took courage and approached Jesus for healing. This encounter between Jesus and the leper tells us the nature of faith as an active, living force that challenges us to place our trust in God's will, even amidst life's uncertainties and trials. It serves as a reminder that our faith, when genuinely embraced, becomes a wellspring of strength and transformation, capable of guiding us toward a path of healing, restoration, and ultimately to wholeness.

Communion Antiphon: God so loved the world that he gave his Only Begotten Son, so that all who believe in him may not perish, but may have eternal life.
