**Entrance Antiphon:** Of you my heart has spoken: Seek his face. It is your face, O Lord, that I seek; hide not your face from me.

Theme: The Gospel describes Transfiguration of Jesus, revealing His divine glory. This event foreshadows the Paschal Mystery — His suffering, death, and resurrection. Jesus reveals his glory to the apostles before they experience crucifixion. It also affirms Jesus as the beloved Son and the fulfilment of the Law and the Prophets, represented by Moses and Elijah. The experience at mount Tabor was a moment of grace for the apostles that enabled them to continue to persevere and trust when they encountered difficulties and trials. On the mountain, the Apostles, were given the vision to look beyond. God reaches out to each of us in such a way that we can journey onwards. Look beyond and see that God is really with us. God has not left us on our own, but He is with us.

**Communion Antiphon:** This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.
