**Theme**: The Gospel tells us that the women from Galilee went to the tomb of Jesus to anoint the body of Jesus. But they found the tomb empty and at the empty tomb they were given the message of His resurrection. They were told. "Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him." As we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord and hear and receive the accounts of disciples encountering the Risen Lord, may we rejoice as the Lord has truly risen. Like Mary Magdalene may we, with eager hearts tell our sisters and brothers what we have witnessed and may we, like them, meet Jesus on the way.
