It serves as a beacon calling us to unite as one family in faith, embracing the profound connection we share through our belief in Christ's presence in the elements of bread and wine. Indeed, Jesus' sacrifice on the cross is the new covenant and it replaces all the other covenants, and through the Eucharist God is present in our everyday life. Now, we are called to live out these teachings by following Jesus' example and sharing His love with others.
