Entrance Antiphon: The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.

Theme: During his public ministry, Jesus went about doing good and proclaiming the nearness of the reign of God. He left his home in Nazareth, along with the carpentry business he likely inherited. While his family remained sympathetic to him, he had forsaken security and safety for a path seemingly on a collision course with the civil and religious authorities of his day. Some less sympathetic individuals accused him of being possessed by a demon, while others levelled harsher charges against him. Despite these accusations, large crowds gathered around him, to the extent that Jesus and his disciples couldn't even find time to eat. Jesus welcomed those who accepted and recognized his ministry; it was these individuals whom Jesus regarded as his family. We have chosen to follow Jesus, and through our celebration, let us proclaim our faith and seek forgiveness and blessing.
