Theme: The scripture readings this week portray God as the giver of life. In the Gospel, two profound miracles unfold. The narrative of Jairus' daughter is interrupted by the healing of a woman afflicted with haemorrhages. Jesus healed the woman on account of her faith and raised Jairus's daughter from death, demonstrating his authority over sickness and death. Through these miracles, Jesus conveys the promise of eternal life and asserts his power over death. He acknowledges the reality of sickness, suffering, and death, yet reveals his power over them. Christ's reassuring words to Jairus were, "Do not be afraid, only have faith." If we earnestly seek him in faith, we will also encounter his divine power in our daily lives.

Communion Antiphon: Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all within me, his holy name.
