Entrance Antiphon: See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good.

Theme: This Sunday's readings highlight God's promise to guide and protect us. Jesus chose twelve men from among his disciples and commissioned them to participate in his mission of teaching, preaching, and healing. Upon their return from their first missionary journey, the apostles reported their experiences to Jesus. Jesus, after listening to them, instructed the apostles to rest and pray. He took them with him to spend time in solitude. However, a crowd followed them, seeking guidance and teaching. Jesus, moved with compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd, took the time to teach them. This compassionate act serves as a model for both the apostles and us, illustrating that effective leadership involves empathetically meeting the needs of others.

Communion Antiphon: Behold, I stand at the door and knock, says the Lord. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door to me, I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me.
