**Entrance Antiphon**: All you have done to us, O Lord, you have done with true judgement, for we have sinned against you and not obeyed your commandments. But give glory to your name and deal with us according to the bounty of your mercy.

**Theme**: The Gospel highlights the disciples' concern about someone casting out demons in Jesus' name, prompting a thoughtful response from Jesus. He encourages inclusivity, emphasizing that anyone doing good in His name is aligned with Him. Jesus calls us to be prophets of God, urging us to have the courage to speak on His behalf in a world that often turns a blind eye to divine mysteries and eternal truths. This passage serves as a reminder of the unity we must strive for in faith, as well as the responsibility we hold to guide others positively in their spiritual journeys.

**Communion Antiphon**: By this we came to know the love of God: that Christ laid down his life for us; so we ought to lay down our lives for one another.

#### 110<sup>th</sup> World Migrant & Refugee Day

Holy Father, Pope Francis' 2024 theme is "God walks with His people". In his message, the Holy Father reminds us that all of us, God's people, are migrants on this earth, on our way to the "true homeland", the Kingdom of Heaven. Migrants are a contemporary icon of this people on a journey. It is in them and in all our brothers and sisters that we can encounter the Lord who walks with us."
