Although Jesus instructed Bartimaeus to go his own way, he chose to follow Jesus instead. Bartimaeus serves as an example of our journey toward God. Are we ready to leave behind our old ways and trust in God fully? Does our faith connect us to God, allowing us to experience His presence and blessings in our daily lives?
